EARTHWORKS ON THE BORDERS RAILWAY

As part of the Border Rail project, CPMS was awarded the contract by Network Rail to infill a redundant fish farm near Galashiels.

The project comprised of the following elements:-

- Clearance of an entire 15 acre fish farm site of redundant equipment, ponds, concrete tanks and sheds.
- Reinstatement of an earth bank of the River Gala.
- Delivery, screen and grading of approximately 35,000 tonnes of recycled inert material sourced from within the Border Rail project.
- Supply and lay of 8,000 tonnes of imported certified topsoil.
- Mechanically pick and remove 600 tonnes of field stone from the existing surface to improve the agricultural potential of the site.
- Cultivate and sow with an agreed agricultural seed, to allow the site to be utilised the following growing year.
- All works completed on time and on budget with no issues.
